

Bible Class Guidelines

SCREENING FORM:

All families **MUST** fill out the screening form before attending classes. You only need to fill the form out **once**, but we ask that you **PLEASE** keep those questions in mind **EVERY TIME** you attend classes.

MASKS:

During Bible classes, masks **are required** for all **adult helpers** and **elementary aged children** (1st-5th grade). Masks are **not required** for children in **Kindergarten** and **younger**.

We will continue to review the need for masks, and this policy will be updated as things change. For now, we believe masks to be beneficial, and that they will help us prevent the spread of COVID-19 within our facilities. As such, we will wear them during Bible classes.

2-5 Year Old Children:

Children should wash their hands before coming to Bible class. (Use the "Little Bathrooms" near the Pre-K hallway) **OR** they can use hand sanitizer on arrival.

We will give each child hand sanitizer at the end of class.

Each child will have their own supply box provided.

At the end of class, each child should be picked up by their parent to go to the auditorium.

1st—5th Grade Children:

Children should wash their hands before coming to Bible class. (Use the North bathrooms or kitchen sinks.) **OR** they can use hand sanitizer on arrival.

We will give each child hand sanitizer at the end of class.

Each child will have their own supply box provided.

NURSERY Children:

Please bring anything your child may need including diapers, bottles, etc.

Our teachers will be wearing masks as they interact with your children to help keep them safe.

CHECK-IN: (For Pre-K and Elementary aged children only)

We will have a volunteer at the check-in desk who will check each child in and print their name tags for them.

This is a great opportunity to review the screening questions as you're coming to Bible class. We trust that you will consider your health and the health of others as you and your children are attending Bible classes. So, we will not ask you to fill out the screening form more than once.
