Humble

In July, the Milwaukee Bucks won the NBA championship with an unlikely star player, Giannis Antetokounmpo.

Antetokounmpo is known as the “Greek Freak.” But this almost seven-footer is a great basketball player, winning Most Valuable Player two years in a row.

His athleticism stands out but even more so does his humility. He keeps himself in perspective. Listen to how he explains it:

“When you focus on the past, that’s your ego. “I did this.” We were able to beat this team 4-0. I did this in the past. And when I focus on the future, it’s my pride. “Yeah, next game, I do this and this and this. I’m going to dominate.” That’s your pride talking. I try to focus in the moment, in the present. And that’s humility. That’s being humble. That’s not setting expectations. That’s going out there and enjoying the game.”

Our society scrambles to elevate an individual. We need to feel more important than others. We need more of the humility Paul spoke about.

“For by the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think with sober judgment, each according to the measure of faith that God has assigned.” (Romans 12:3)

Humility is knowing the gift of God in your life and using it to your potential. It doesn’t worry about what others see, feel, or think. It only wants to serve the needs of the Giver of the grace.

You may never wear a championship ring, but you can reflect the gifts God gives.
